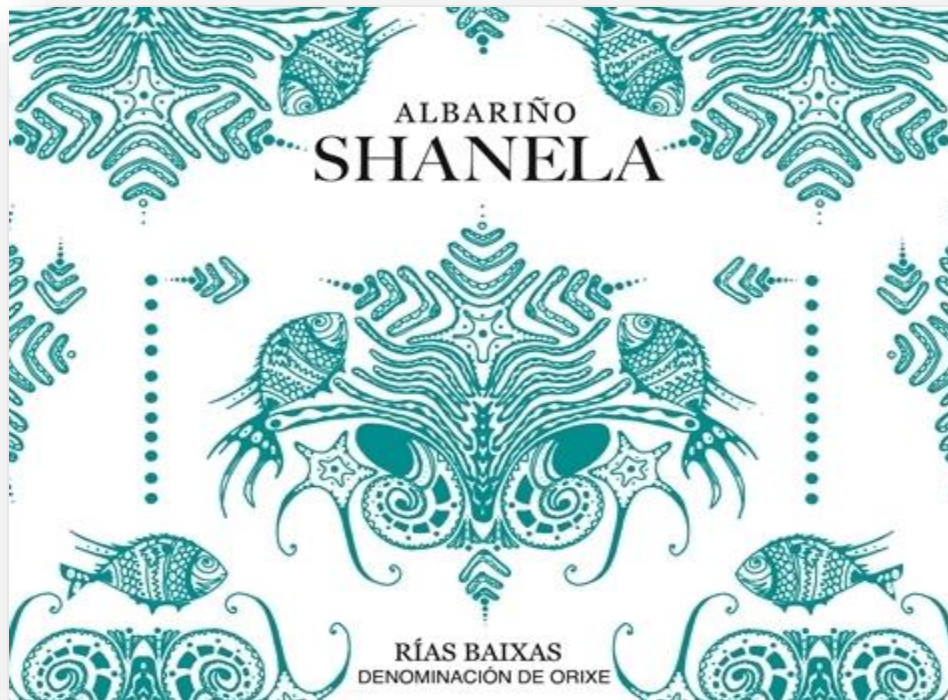


Bodegas Bhilar (Rias Baixas)

Xanela (pronounced Shanela) is the Galician word for window, located on the Atlantic coast, this small parcel offers a window to the sea. It is aged for 16 months sur lie in a combination of stainless steel and neutral French oak barrels.
